Dexter can't contain Hamilton in 54-42 fall to Monroe

Travon Hamilton is fast.

For Dexter, too fast, as the Dreadnaughts couldn't keep up with Hamilton and Monroe, resulting in a 54-42 loss in a Southeastern Conference contest Friday in Dexter.

"We tried to stop his (Hamilton's) speed, but he was just too fast," Dexter coach Tom Barbieri said. "He was awfully quick."

Hamilton ended with a game-high 183 yards on eight carries and four touchdowns.

Dexter (2-6) managed to hold a 14-12 lead after the first quarter, but three second-quarter touchdowns from Monroe put the Dreadnaughts behind 33-21 at halftime.

"We just didn't have as many guns as they had," Barbieri said. "It was back and forth."

Monroe maintained the lead for the entire second half to preserve the win.

Mike Mioduscewski led the Dexter offense with three touchdown passes, one rushing touchdown and 368 yards throwing. All of Mioduscewski's touchdown passes were caught by Mike Kedroske in the first half.

Sequoyah Burke-Combs led Dexter in rushing yards with 99, including a fourth-quarter touchdown. Rob Maynrand led the team in tackles with five solos and eight assists.
